

A Bill to Reinstate the Military Draft

1 **Be it enacted by the Student Congress here assembled that:**

2 **Section 1:** All residents of the United States register with the Selective Service within ten
3 (10) days of their eighteenth (18th) birthdays.

4 **Section 2:** Residents who fail to register will be subject to a twenty-five thousand dollar
5 (\$25,000) fine and/or a prison sentence of five (5) years.

6 **Section 3:** Deferments will be granted to those exhibiting a history of medical or mental
7 disabilities; to those enrolled in U.S. military colleges or ROTC programs; and
8 to those pursuing critical training or occupations as defined by the Selective
9 Service.

10 **Section 4:** On January 5 of each year, a draft lottery will be held for those potential draftees
11 who will celebrate their nineteenth (19th) birthdays in that calendar year.

12 **Subpoint A:** In independent drawings, 365 dates will be drawn simultaneously
13 with 365 numbers (366 of each in leap years). The numbers will
14 determine the order in which draftees' birthdays will report for
15 military service, if and when they are called.

16 **Subpoint B:** Persons between the ages of 20 and 25 at the time of the first
17 drawing will be subject to the draft in the same order as that first
18 drawing.

19 **Section 5:** Persons who are drafted and serve will be eligible for expanded coverage under
20 the GI Bill for both college-tuition and job-training benefits.

21 **Section 6:** This legislation shall go into effect on January 1 following its passage.

A Bill to Fund Embryonic Stem Cell Research

1 **Be it enacted by the Student Congress here assembled that:**

2 **Section 1:** Embryonic stem cell research be funded by the federal government.

3 **Section 2:** Laws making the harvesting of embryos illegal be made null and void with the passage

4 of this legislation.

5 **Section 3:** The cloning of human embryos be permitted.

6 **Section 4:** Funding for this research be made through existing NSF and NIH budgets.

7 **Section 5:** This legislation shall go into effect one month after its passage.
